



Assembly Combo

COMPOST BIN(S) – COPIOUS LEAF COMPOSTER – LOG STORE

Log Store goes at the end of Compost Bins or Leaf Stores.

Contents: **COMPOST BINS**

Single: 20 Boards 4 Posts

Twin: 35 Boards 6 Posts

Triple: 50 Boards 8 Posts

Module: 15 Boards 2 Posts

Long: 10 Long Boards, 10 Short Boards,
4 Posts

A flat stone, a piece of slate or **Post Slippers** under each post will extend the life of the post. Complete the Compost Bin(s) first.

1. Slide a groove of a corner post over one end of a board.
2. Take a second corner post and slide it over the other end of the board.
3. Repeat to form a square from 4 posts and 4 boards.
4. Slide another board down one side and repeat, building the sides to POST height keeping any Baton Boards for the top layer on which to rest the lids

Modules: Assemble as for the complete bin using one side of the existing bin for the fourth side.

3.5m Strong Netting

6 Plastic Slats

Zip Ties

Modules have three sides to enable them to be an addition to a larger unit, or for example another Copious Leaf Composter a Log Store or Compost Bin. Therefore three sided Modules need to attach to one side of another product.

1. Make a 3 sided unit with the Posts and the THICK Boards. Attach this to one side of another product. Include the two posts on the chosen side of the other unit.
2. Slide a Plastic Slat down a Post groove above the end of one of the boards. Repeat until there is a Plastic Slat above each end of each of three boards.
3. Finish off by sliding the Standard Boards into the top of the frame.
4. Unroll the netting and place inside the frame. Secure with Zip Ties.

When assembling the Log Store next to the Compost Bin or Leaf Composter it is necessary to replace the two posts and the top board on the common side of the Compost Bin with sloped posts and a sloped board. This is to take the slope of the Felted Lid for the Log Store and make it secure.
