



Assembly **FITTING LIDS AND FLOORS**

The essence of fitting lids and floors relies on boards that have fixed batons. These boards are provided with your purchase.

In the case of **Floors** the Baton Boards are placed facing inside the unit, opposite each other at the level they are needed. In most cases this will be on the bottom layer but may vary.

In the case of **Lids** the same principal applies, but the Baton Boards will be placed on the top layer of the unit usually on the left and right ends. Multiple lids will have double Baton Boards. These should be placed on the top row in between units.

In all cases there will be some movement to provide for expansion and contraction when the wood gets wet. In some products you will have a liner provided for the unit you have purchased. In the case of a growing bed it is advisable to puncture the liner lightly a few times to allow excess water to drain away.
