



Assembly  
**MY REAL NURSERY GARDEN**  
**RAISED BED ON LEGS - SQUARE - LONG - CLOCHE**

**Raised Bed with Legs**

**Components:**

**4 Posts**

**2 Baton Boards**

**6 Boards**

**8 Plastic strips**

**1 Floor**

**Liner**

**Slippers to go under the feet**

Starting upside down.

- Place the 4 posts into a rough square and join together by sliding boards into the slots in the sides of the posts. For the 2<sup>nd</sup> row use the Baton Boards on opposite sides with the batons facing inwards. Add the remaining Boards also on opposite sides to complete this row.
- Place the slats into the post groves, one slat over each end of the boards making sure that they go down as far as possible.
- Turn the Raised Bed over to stand on the legs. Place the floor to rest on the Baton Boards
- Punch a few drainage holes in the liner if used. Place the slippers under the feet.

**Cloche** - A temporary fitted poly-tunnel for all Gardening Works Raised Beds

For My Real Garden Raised Beds you will need:

2 Hoops - each is ½ of a 2.5M plastic  
slat.

6 Clips

Sheet of Polythene for the cover

- Hoops are slotted diagonally into the groves of the posts
- Place the cover over the bed
- Fix with Spring Clips
