

<u>Assembly</u>

OTTOMAN - TOY BOX - BLANKET BOX - STORAGE BOX

AN UNTREATED HOUSEHOLD STORAGE BOX READY FOR DIY FINISHES

No Nails and No Screws except any Lid hinges. Pictures on the website will be helpful.

If you have a Square Ottoman/Toy/Blanket - Storage Box all the Boards will be the same length. For a Long Rectangular Ottoman/Toy/Blanket - Storage Box, half of the panels and thin slats will be shorter on the sides.

You may have chosen the option of a lid with Hinges.

Standard Storage Box uses standard 1.5cm boards with a thicker top board for the hinges. Superior Storage Boxes - all boards are the same 2cm thickness.

It is important to fix the Slippers for protection and stability. Use Low Modular Silicone glue. Wood is untreated to enable you to add your own colour, transfers etc.

Contents:

4 Posts

1 Floor

1 Lid

2 Baton Boards

Boards

4 Narrow Wooden Slats if required for this

size of Box

1 Thick, top Board for hinge lid option

4 Post Slippers

Assembly:

- 1. Connect 2 posts with a Baton Board. The batons face inside and at the bottom.
- 2. Make a square (or rectangle) with posts and 2 baton boards, front and back. This will give you the footprint of the Storage Box that you purchased.
- 3. Place the Floor on the Batons
- 4. Build up the back by adding boards and, if provided, a thin slat, finishing with the thicker 2cm board for the hinges on top for the hinged lid option.
- 5. Build up the sides and front panel to the top.
- 6. Position the Lid. a) with the hinges to the back. Mark the position of the hinges.
- 7. Screw the lid hinges to the back panel outside
